ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. These orders are to come into force immediately and to remain in force until final determination of the application before the Commission or earlier order of the Court.
2. Pursuant to s 262(4)(a) of the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld) I direct that the unprotected industrial action engaged in by the Queensland Teachers Union of Employees (QTU) namely the directive issued to its members on 7 October 2020 that “all QTU members are hereby directed to cease all activities associated with the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) for the remainder of 2020 and the 2021 school year” is to immediately cease and to not recommence.
3. The QTU is to communicate that information, namely the contents of orders 1 and 2 above, to its members by 4.00 pm on 27 January 2021 by emailing a copy of these orders to each of their members.
4. The QTU shall file an affidavit with the Industrial Registrar by 4.00 pm on 28 January 2021 as to whether there has been compliance with these orders.
5. Each party shall have liberty to apply to the Commission as to the progress of the application.
6. The appeal is otherwise dismissed.
7. There be no order as to costs.
