UNION REPRESENTATIVES IN SCHOOLS

Nominations are hereby called for Union Representatives in schools/workplaces.

The staff of a school/workplace are entitled to elect two Union Representatives where up to 15 are appointed to the staff, and an additional Union Representative for each additional 15 members or part thereof. Provided that no fewer than 50 per cent of the Union Representatives at a school or workplace shall be female if sufficient female candidates nominate for the positions.

Where more than one nomination is received for the position and there are not sufficient positions available and where a school already has an allocation of additional Union Representatives, or the General Secretary determines not to grant an additional allocation, an election will be held between the current Union Rep team and those nominated. In such circumstances, the General Secretary will advise the existing Workplace Reps of the nominations of Representatives more than the school's allocation and of their intention to conduct an election.

Should existing Representatives, or any duly nominated Representatives, wish not to participate in the election, the General Secretary will treat this advice as a request to resign from the position, or to withdraw their nomination.

Following this process, members at the workplace will be advised of the intent to conduct an election for the Representative team.

The rule requiring at least 50 per cent of the Union Representatives in a workplace to be female; and a First Nations member (should one nominate) will continue to apply in these circumstances

Elections caused under this section will only occur once in a three-year period.

Where ballot is necessary, the optional preferential method of voting shall be used. Nominees must exhibit:

- support for QTU member working conditions and directives
- involvement in QTU activities, e.g. legal seminars, QTEC training days
- involvement in QTU structures, e.g. committee member
- continuity in their QTU membership.

E WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

The Committee will usually meet quarterly (or more frequently if required) after school hours at The Teachers' Building, Milton and/ or online. The committee is responsible for matters pertaining to the Work Health and Safety Act (2011) Qld, particularly growing an explicit physical and psychosocial safety culture, promoting mechanisms to embed safe systems of work including appropriate WHS consultation practices, effective WHS responses to occupational violence and aggression, effective incident reporting systems, and other emerging issues. Teleconference facilities will be available for those members who live outside the South-East corner of Queensland. The committee will meet face to face as required for policy workshops in the lead up to Biennial Conference, subject to the approval of senior officers
